Dear Parent / Carer,

We are very excited to inform you that after half term, we will be launching our brand new savings club entitled 'Lifesavers'. This club is run by school with the Credit Union and gives children the opportunity to save their own money each week.

The club will run each Friday morning from 8.20am – 8.40am and pupils are invited to bring in any amount from 10p upwards and add this to their savings account. This money will be saved with the Bradford Credit Union who have over 6500 members and 12 LifeSavers schools. Children will be able to withdraw 3 times a year via an electronic transfer to a parents account. The club is run by children from school who have been trained to use the online system and this will be overseen by Mrs Andrews and Mrs Nixon.

In order to set up an account for your child, please click on the link below and add your child's details – it takes no longer than 30 seconds.

You will then receive an email asking you to send over one of the following;

**ID** – Passport / Driving License / Tenancy agreement form housing association (not private landlord)

**Address** – Recent DWP (Benefits) / Bank statement / Utility Bill

*A photo of the ID above can be taken with a smartphone / tablet and sent via email, there is no need to take or send this ID anywhere.*

Once you have done this, your child's account will be opened, you will be sent account details and your child can begin to save. They will be given a passbook and wallet for them to keep track of how much they have saved.

This is a really exciting opportunity for the whole school and Cavendish so we encourage as many children to sign up as possible. If you would like any help in signing up, we will be pleased to help you so please come into the office where someone will assist you.
