ABOUT THE SCHOOL

Cavendish is a two form entry Community Primary School in Eccleshill, Bradford with fourteen classes catering for children aged 4 – 11 years and a 40/40 FTE place nursery. Currently, we have 463 pupils on roll.

The position of the school boasts wonderful views and we are lucky to have extensive grounds which contain a vegetable garden, orchard and pond as well as different areas for play and quiet areas. We use our school grounds and surrounding area to enrich the curriculum.

The large majority of pupils are White British and the proportion of pupils of minority ethnic heritage and those who speak English as an additional language is well below average. Pupils are taught in mixed-ability classes. A much higher than average proportion of pupils are supported by the pupil premium.

We want all those who become part of our school community, whether a child or an adult, to feel valued, happy, respected and to recognise their role in supporting us to make our school outstanding.
