ordering numbers body parts self portraits

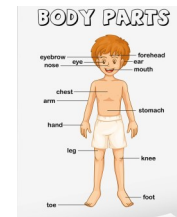
History – Spend some time talking to your family about your family history. Children can bring in photos or items relating to their family history.



Art - Children can make their own self portraits or portraits of their family members. They can use any materials they wish.



Science— Who am I? Children to identify and label their body parts.



Maths - Write their numbers 0-20 forwards and backwards.



Science— Who am I? Identify the five senses and talk about which body part is related to which sense.



English – Write words or simple sentences about what you enjoy doing at home. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



History— Have a go at drawing your own family tree. Be creative!



Maths – Try adding and subtracting using numbers 0-10 or using objects.



Reading— Share a book with an adult. It could be fiction or non-fiction. Can you read a word / sentence / full story?
