Maths - Write your own addition number sentences. Can you write the addition number sentence in 4 different ways.



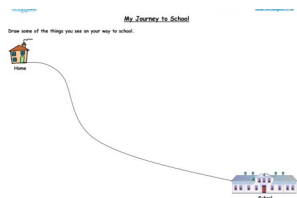
Science— Celebrations— Draw or write a list of things which are sources of light.
