In PSHE we are learning all about friends and family. In English we are reading the story 'Portside Pirates'. In phonics we are learning how instruments make different sounds and how to distinguish between them!	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use different items in your house as instruments e.g. spoon and pan, pasta/rice in a pot to shake, yoghurt pots and sticks – can you think of any more ideas? - Talk about the different sounds the instruments make e.g. high, low etc. hide the instruments and play one – can they guess which one it is? 	https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/1
