In PSHE we are learning to: Explain the difference between unkindness, teasing and bullying Understand that bullying is usually quite rare.	Talk about what it means to be unkind, to tease and to bully. Think of and discuss different scenarios for each heading.	BBC Bitesize videos about teasing and bullying. The sounds we are learning this week are oo, ar, air, or, ir,	Write some words with the sounds in and help your child read them. Help your child to write some words with the sounds in. In Maths we are learning to find number bonds for numbers within 10.	Giving your child a number within 10 and some objects (Lego bricks, counters, pegs). Move one object over at a time and find all the ways to make that number. Write the number sentence; $1 + 9 = 10$	Click <a href="#">here</a> to watch some useful videos	Practise counting in 5s.
