In PSHE we are learning to: Explain some of our school rules and how those rules help to keep everybody safe.	Talking about the rules they have in school and in their classroom. Discuss why they think they have to follow those rules.	BBC Bitesize videos about personal safety.  Click <a href="#">here</a>	Create a poster on a school rule and write a sentence about how that rule keeps you safe.
Our story this week is the traditional tale of 'Cinderella'	Talking about and drawing the main events in the story to create a story map. Children to write a sentence/key words describing the main events.	A video of the story.  Click <a href="#">here</a>	Draw the main characters in the story and describe the characters using adjectives.
The sounds we are learning this week are ou, oy, qu, th, ch	Write some words with the sounds in and help your child read them. Help your child to write some words with the sounds in.	Videos to introduce the sounds: <a href="#">ou</a> <a href="#">oy</a> <a href="#">qu</a> <a href="#">th</a> <a href="#">ch</a>	Find items around the house with the sounds you have been learning in the word.
In Maths we are learning addition within 10.	You can use objects or food from around the home and introduce number stories to your child. "If we have two chocolate chip cookies, and 3 digestives. How many biscuits do we have altogether? Let's count them and see."	Click <a href="#">here</a> to watch some useful videos	Practise counting in 10s.
In English we are learning to write character descriptions using adjectives.  We are also learning about using the conjunction 'because' in our writing.	Talk about what adjectives are and share some examples. Children can draw a character from their favourite story and describe the character using adjectives.
