In PSHE we are learning to: Identify some of the people who are special to us. Recognise and name some of the qualities that make a person special to us.	Talking about the special people in your life and discussing why they are special. Children can draw their special person and write a sentence about why they are special to them. Our story this week is the traditional tale of 'Cinderella'	Talking about and creating your own fairy tale story. Draw a story map for your fairy tale story.	A video of the story. Click <u>here</u>	Write or draw what you would do if you had your very own fairy godmother.
The sounds we are learning this week are ea, oi, a-e, i-e, o-e	Write some words with the sounds in and help your child read them. Help your child to write some words with the sounds in.	Videos to introduce the sounds: ea oi a-e i-e o-e	Find items around the house with the sounds you have been learning in the word.
In Maths we are learning about number bonds to 10 and adding more.	You can use objects around the home to show your child a number less than 10 and ask the child to show you how many more you need to make 10.	Click <u>here</u> to watch some useful videos	Practise counting to 100.
In English we are learning to write a letter. We are also learning about using the conjunction 'because' in our writing.	Talk about what letters are and why we might write letters to people. Discuss the key features; address, who it is addressed to and who it is from.	Click here to help you understand how to use conjunctions such as 'because' correctly.	Children to write a letter to someone with a purpose. E.g. write a letter to Santa with what you want for Christmas.
