History— Children to research and create a poster about the first flight.



DT — Children to make simple instructions on how to make a fruit kebab. Children to describe what a fruit kebab tastes like using adjectives.



Science — On Safari — Children to go on a walk to explore invertebrates, bugs and minibeasts in the local area.



Maths - Children to be given an amount within 10 and practice doubling and halving. Children can halve and share the food they eat or the toys they play with.



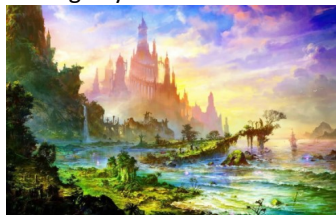
Science — On Safari — Children to research their favourite minibeast and to create it using materials at home.
