**Final Information - Ingleborough Hall – 11<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> October 2021**

Dear Parent/Carer,

The Year 6 residential is fast approaching so I would like to inform you of some final arrangements.

**Drop off**

On Monday 11<sup>th</sup> October, please bring your child with their bag to the main office door where they will be shown into the hall. We are aiming to leave shortly after 9am so please make sure children arrive on time. Miss Morkan will be at the door to collect any **medication** (this includes travel sickness tablets and inhalers). You will be asked to complete a short form about the type of medication, the dosage and times it needs to be given.

Children need to bring a packed lunch unless they receive free school meals, in which case they will be provided with a packed lunch. Lunches will travel on the coach with the children but all other luggage will be placed underneath. There is limited space on both the coach and in the rooms so please only bring a small bag with necessary items. The journey will take just over an hour.

There is a small tuck shop at Ingleborough Hall which sells pencils, rubbers, sweets and keyrings etc. If your child would like to buy something then **please send no more than £5** (preferably in coins rather than a note) and hand this to Mrs Whitbread on the Monday morning. We will then put it into a named envelope and keep it safely.


**Collection**
