**History** – Look through your photo albums at home can you find picture of yourselves ? How have you changed over time?

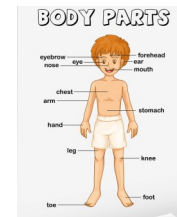
Talk to your grown ups how have they changed?

**Science— Who am I?** Identify the five senses and talk about which body part is related to which sense.



**English** – Write words or simple sentences about what you enjoy doing at home. Remember to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



**History—** Have a go at creating a timeline of how you have changed from baby to now?



**Maths** – Try adding and subtracting using numbers 0-10 or using objects.



**Reading—** Share a book with an adult. It could be fiction or non-fiction. Can you read a word / sentence / full story?
