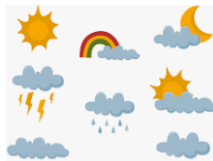

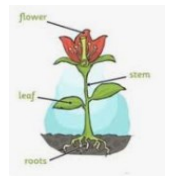
**Geography**— Children to identify the four seasons and to draw the changes for each season. Children to describe what the weather is like each day and how do they prepare for the weather.



**DT** — Children to write simple instructions on how to make a fruit kebab. Children to describe what a fruit kebab tastes like using adjectives.



**Science** — children to draw and label the different parts of a plant. Children could write simple sentences to explain the important job of each part of the plant.



**Maths** - Children to be given an amount within 10 and practise doubling and halving. Children can halve by sharing the food they eat or the toys they play with.



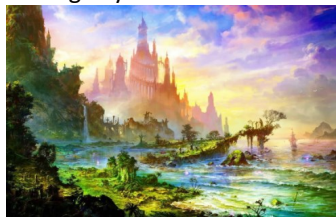
**Science** — children could go for a walk to a local area and see if they can spot any deciduous or evergreen plants around them. How do they know?



**English** – Children to draw their favourite dinosaur and to describe it using adjectives. Children to create a story map about their dinosaur.



**English**— Children to create their own fantasy setting and to describe it using key words.



**Maths** – Children to complete simple addition and subtraction sums using Numbots.



**Reading**— Share a book with an adult. It could be fiction or non-fiction. Can you read a word / sentence / full story?
